Security

- ✓ On 27th November, SAPS held a public meeting at Bay Primary School.
- ✓ The meeting was well attended, and the new Muizenberg Station Commander, Colonel Daniels, introduced himself and stressed they would be more visible in future.
- ✓ The main issues raised at the meeting were drug related problems and car guards.
- ✓ The selection of a Community Police Forum Committee from the local residents present took place.
- ✓ The SRA security patrollers now have a monitoring system that tracks all patrols.
- ✓ The SRA has conducted a survey of possible sites for CCTV surveillance cameras, in order to fit future installations into an overall master plan for the SRA area.
- ✓ During November SAPS made 5 arrests in our area, 3 were drug related and 2 were for the illlegal possession of unlicensed firearms.
- ✓ Mountain Men made 3 arrests in November, 1 for possession of stolen goods, 2 for trespassing.

Cleaning

- ✓ The bathing boxes at St James beach have been given a bright new coat of paint in time for the holiday season!
- ✓ This is thanks to the initiative of a St James resident, paint provided by the City Council, supply of labour by another St James resident and a "top up" contribution by the SRA.
- ✓ This is another example of how our community, working together, can achieve successes and improve our environment.

Social Worker

- ✓ Ester Uys has made contact with the local schools in the area.
 ✓ The Principals have given Ester details of possible homes where there may be problems.
- ✓ Ester has undertaken a number of visits to these homes to assist where possible.
- ✓ Ester is working closely with The Haven Night Shelter as well as Waves For Change.

Management

- ✓ Our Special General Meeting (SGM) was held on the 1st December.
- ✓ There were 137 registered members of the Company of whom 67 were present, thus fulfilling the quorum requirement 28 registered members, being 20% of registered members.
- ✓ The meeting was therefore declared to be quorate.
